The Terms and Conditions detailed below apply to all those participating in the Muckle Toon Adventure Company Ltd. Completion of an entry form or purchase of an entry by every participant acknowledges acceptance of these Terms and Conditions by the participant.

1. The participant is fully responsible for their actions whilst attending the event. This includes Basecamp and during the event itself. The Muckle Toon Adventure Company does not accept responsibility for the actions of the participant nor the consequences of such actions.
2. Each participant is responsible for providing their own insurance protection for their participation in the event. Payment of the Event Entry fee to The Muckle Toon Adventure Company Ltd does not include any insurance protection for accident, sickness or negligence of any individual participant. Any accident or injury caused by any participant will be the full responsibility of said participant.
3. Each participant will be fully responsible for any fees or costs incurred or arising from an accident either involving or caused by the participant. This includes, but is not exclusive to, fees from Police, Air Ambulance, Fire and Rescue and the Ambulance service. If the situation arises that you are not capable of making the decision to call the emergency services, the participant agrees that a member of The Muckle Toon Adventure Company Ltd or a member of the public may call for them. In this situation, the participant still accepts the costs and consequences of such actions.
4. The Event registration form must be completed by a person aged 18 years or over. Evidence of age may be requested by The Muckle Toon Adventure Company Ltd. Participants under the age of 18 years will be allowed to participate in the event with the consent of their parents or legal guardian who must sign the Event Registration Form on behalf of the under-age participant. Signing is also an acceptance for the actions and consequences of the underage Participant.
5. Each participant, upon signing the registration form, agrees that they are physically and mentally capable of participation at the distance they have chosen. If, during the event, they decide to change their route and distance, then all consequences of this action are theirs.
6. The participant agrees to wear for all activities those identified as essential on the The Muckle Toon Adventure Company Ltd website. This can include, but is not exclusive to, a suitably designed cycling specific helmet and appropriate footwear for such events. The Muckle Toon Adventure Company Ltd reserves the right to refuse entry to the event to anyone with inappropriate equipment or clothing.
7. The participant confirms that all of their equipment is of a suitable Standard. In particular, mountain bikes should be capable of performing for the longest distance ride available, and over rough terrain.
8. Any marked route is shown for guidance only and The Muckle Toon Adventure Company Ltd do not insist that you use the route shown. Therefore if the rider chooses to undertake a section, it is entirely their own choice. If they choose a different route to avoid obstacles or sections they decide are beyond their capabilities, they do so entirely at their own risk.
9. During the event there will be warning signs at appropriate points on the trails or roads. Absence of these signs does not signal there are no dangers approaching and it is the individual rider's responsibility to make a decision regarding whether to undertake a section or not. The marking of the route does not necessarily indicate that the trail or road is in good condition and the participant is deemed to make their own decision about whether to proceed on bike, foot or not at all.
10. The participants agree to return to the event centre at the end of their event and report to a member of staff. Not doing so will mean that a search may be organised and the subsequent cost will be billed to the rider.
11. Event entry fees may be refunded or transferred at the discretion of the MTAC
12. By entering any event, the participant consents to interview(s), photography, audio recording, video recording and its/their release, publication, exhibition, or reproduction to be used for promotional purposes by the The Muckle Toon Adventure Company Ltd and its affiliates and representatives. You release The Muckle Toon Adventure Company Ltd, its officers and employees, and each and all

persons involved from any liability connected with the taking, recording, digitising, or publication of interviews, photographs, computer images, video and/or or sound recordings. The participant waives all rights they may have to any claims for payment or royalties in connection with the publication of these materials. The participant also waives any right to inspect or approve any photo, video, or audio recording taken by The Muckle Toon Adventure Company Ltd or the person or entity designated to do so by The Muckle Toon Adventure Company Ltd.

Refund Policy

- If the Event is cancelled, no refunds shall be given if the event is re-scheduled within a 6 month period of the original published date.
- If the Event has had to be cancelled in advance of its taking place and is not re-scheduled, entry fees and/or associated event purchases shall be refunded in full by the organisers upon written request. All such requests must be sent to the Organiser by recorded delivery post to the above address. Refunds shall be paid within 28 days of the written request by the Competitor to the Organiser for the refunded monies. These refunds shall be made to the person requesting the refund only.
- An entrant may switch their entry to a friend 14 working days before the prior to the event if full disclosure of the new participant details are given to the event company.
- The Organiser's refund policy is subject to change at the discretion of the Organiser and any such changes are published either within this refund policy and/ or on the Event website. The Participant is advised to visit the Event website regularly.
